

# Palm Frond

(Matthew 21:1-11)



## Supplies you'll need:

## Instructions:

1. Trace and cut out three hands like the example.
2. Color tongue depressor green.
3. Print out: "Hosanna to the Son of David!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Hosanna in the highest!" Cut the verse out and glue or tape to one hand.
4. Glue or tape hands onto tongue depressor. Be sure the hand with the verse is in the front like the example shown.

# Easter Sunrise Craft



## Supplies you'll need:

- ☐ Paper Plate, any size (1 per child)
- ☐ Paint, Crayons or Colored Pencils
- ☐ Black Construction Paper
- ☐ Glue or Stapler
- ☐ White Crayon or Pen (optional)

## Instructions:

1. Instruct children to color a sunrise on the paper plate, starting with yellow, then adding orange, red, purple and finally blue.
2. Fold black construction paper in half and cut out crosses (or precut, depending on age).
3. Attach black construction paper to paper plate using a stapler or glue (we used staples).
4. Optional: Write a Bible verse or "He is Risen!" on the bottom of the black construction paper.
